Bring your own Lunch; it's a long way to restaurants.

For Outside Use, Bring:

- 1) Your plein air easel, paints etc. A limited number of "loaner" plein air easels will be available for use during the class; if you need to, ask now to reserve one.
- 2) 5 to 6 Watercolor papers or canvas panels, depending on the medium you use; suggested sizes: 5 x 7, 6 x 8 or 8 x10", square optional
- 3) The board you usually use to tape your paper to.
- 4) Chair if you prefer to sit outside while painting.
- 5) Umbrella or hat for sun protection. Sunscreen

Basic Materials For Use Inside & Outside:

- 1) Palette
- 2) Paint: Your usual colors & medium (suggested: watercolor, acrylic, pastels, colored pencil, gouache, ink), also some colors that you have but might not have used yet!
- 3) Water containers including spray bottle for water
- 4) Extra rags or roll of paper towel

Materials For Inside Warm Up Exercises:

- 1) Additional drawing and mark-making supplies (pencils, watercolor crayons, markers, pastels, markers). You don't need to buy anything; Bring what you have, or ask me.
- 2) 4oz Black tempera paint, or fluid acrylic craft paint, or small India ink
- 3) 2 large white poster boards (\$1.25 at dollar stores)
- 4) 11 x 14 inexpensive sketch pad
- 5) Sketchbook / journal / pen, pencils
- 6) Masking tape or painters tape
- 7) Old credit card or hotel key card
- 8) 1" & 2" chip brush - cheap (from hardware or paint store) about \$1 each
- 9) 1" & 2" foam brush (larger if you can find it)
- 10) Scissors and a ruler
- 11) Variety of brush sizes & shapes (larger is better), maybe ones you haven't used yet!

Bring an open minded ATTITUDE.
